POSITION SUMMARY:

Trinidad State Junior College is seeking qualified applicants to teach UAS curricula at the Alamosa Campus located in Alamosa Colorado, Colorado. This part-time, nine-month, position will report directly to the Dean of Instruction.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Instruct students in assigned courses in accordance with established curriculum and college procedures.
- Use effective teaching methods and technologies to meet the diverse learning styles of students.
- Maintain and distribute current course syllabi using the accepted template.
- Maintain accurate records.
- Submit grades, schedule additions, course syllabi and other reports or required documents by established deadlines.
- Be aware of and follow established polices of the State Board, CCCS, and the College.
- Assess learning outcomes, demonstrate the use of assessment results in course planning, report and maintain assessment records, and participate in assessment activities (i.e. "A" day and ALTITUDE conference).
- Develop and revise curriculum to maintain the quality and relevancy of course offerings.
- Notify the appropriate associate dean or dean if the faculty member is going to be absent from work. This notification should be made in a timely manner.
- Discuss with appropriate personnel any problems of students, which may require special attention and provide records as needed.
- Review and recommend appropriate textbooks and maintain classroom supplies as needed for successful teaching of assigned classes.
- Incorporate learning resources and technologies in courses whenever possible.
- Engage in professional development activities to maintain a current knowledge of subject matter and teaching methodology.
- Meet all classes as scheduled.
- Adhere to professional standards of conduct.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Possess a current FAA 14 CFR Part 107 certificate.
- Be able to safely fly and oversee the flight of both fixed and rotary wing Small Unmanned Aviation Vehicles (sUAV drones).
- Must be able to teach all UAS courses within the TSJC Catalog in face-to-face, on-line, and field formats.
- Functional knowledge of UAS emerging technologies and capabilities.
- Functional knowledge of Microsoft Suite for PC/Mac;
- Must be agreeable to working with a diverse population and with all ranges of student abilities; and

- Must have a strong commitment and positive attitude toward Community College instruction;
- Other duties as assigned.

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Experience in On-line course development;
- Community College teaching experience;
- Experience with Desire2Learn or similar learning management system;
- Computer programming experience;
- Desire to progress professionally in the industry: and
- Proof of flight experience.
