

## Changes to Occupational Safety and Health Technology Program Curriculum – Effective Summer Semester 2017

In order to improve the OSH course descriptions, competencies, and credit hours, as well as overall curriculum requirements for the OSHT program, there are several changes that will be coming to the program beginning with the Summer 2017 semester. A crosswalk of old and new course numbers, titles, and credit hours is noted below, with new items in bold.

Please know that these changes do not affect the program content and instruction; rather, they are bringing course information in line with current and future course content. Also, if you have already completed a course with a different number or name within the past five years, that course will still count toward your graduation requirements.
