A NEW CAREER IN FOUR MONTHS?

The Heavy Equipment Operations program at Trinidad State is designed to prepare students for professional construction work. Students will learn workplace safety and applied mathematics, in addition to hands-on supervised instruction in equipment operation and preventive maintenance.

The program is NCCER certified, which means the training is written to an industry standard and credentials are portable. Learners who complete NCCER training are equipped to meet the labor demands of employers around the world, enhancing their employment opportunities. NCCER statistics show that heavy equipment operators in Colorado earn an average of over \$62,000 a year. This 25-credit hour certificate can be earned in one semester.

According to the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics, the projected growth of employment for heavy equipment operators is expected to increase 10% between 2018 and 2028, which is a quicker average than other occupations. Heavy equipment operators who are trained to operate multiple types of equipment have the best job opportunities.
