The Business Program at Trinidad State is designed to offer two options for students. The Transfer Ready Path allows students to complete the lower-division (freshman and sophomore) portion of a Bachelor of Arts (BA) degree prior to moving on to a university, and the Career Ready Path offers students the opportunity to develop work-related skills while gaining fundamental knowledge to enter the job market more quickly earning an Associate of Applied Science (AAS). In addition to the AAS, students can earn a 2-year certificate or specific certificates as in Accounting Clerk, Basic Job Skills, Entrepreneurial Operations, Office Basics, Office Professional, or Team Leadership.

Business classes will be offered during the summer including some evening options. The summer schedule will be available in mid-March

Introduction to Gunsmithing

June 6-10, 2022

No prior experience is required for this class. This is the perfect opportunity to make an improvement to one or more of your firearms and learn a little about the firearms industry with an expert to guide you. The course will cover operational theory, disassembly and assembly, proper use of hand tools and precision measuring instruments, and an introduction to basic bench work of the Gunsmithing trade. Consideration will be given to minor gun repair and the installation of firearm accessories. A brief study of Federal Firearm Law and record keeping will be included.

Students should bring some type of project to work on during lab times under the supervision of the instructor, Ryan Newport.
