Introduction to Gunsmithing June 5-9, 2023 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

This class is just what you need to fix the firearm Grandpa left to you or learn to install accessories yourself. <u>No prior experience is necessary!</u> Learn operational theory, disassembly and assembly, proper use of hand tools and precision measuring instruments, and an introduction to basic bench work of the Gunsmithing trade. Consideration will be given to minor gun repair and the installation of firearm accessories. A brief study of Federal Firearm Law and record



keeping will be included. Cost of the class is \$400 for 40 hours of instruction. (plus a registration fee) A complete description including a tool list is available at:

CompTIA[™] Network+ Certification Training

Prepare for a career as a network technician and qualify to take the CompTIA Network+ certification exam as you master basic networking concepts and gain a fundamental knowledge of network design, security, routing, and switching.

\$1,645 (or as low as \$80 a month with affirm financing). You will receive a voucher to take the CompTIA Network+exam, a value of \$358

CompTIA Network+ is a vendor-neutral, entry-level certification widely recognized by the information technology (IT) industry. Achieving this certification prepares technicians to work in IT infrastructure by providing key networking knowledge and skills.

After obtaining your CompTIA Network+ certification, you are qualified for jobs such as a network administrator, IT consultant, network field engineer, computer technician, help desk technician, system engineer, network support specialist, and network analyst.

The average CompTIA Network+ salary is \$73,530 annually, according to ZipRecruiter, which equates to approximately \$35.35 an hour.

CompTIA Network+ annual salaries can reach as high as \$144,000 and as low as \$28,500. Still, the majority of Network+ salaries currently range between \$52,000 (25th percentile) to \$90,000 (75th percentile), with top earners (90th percentile) making \$123,000 annually across the U.S. Pay is based on skill level, location, and years of experience.

This course is an open enrollment online course, so you can register and start the course as soon as you are ready. Access to your course can take 24-48 business hours.
