Colorado First and Existing Industry Training Mini Grants for Small Business

Skill Advance Colorado is piloting Colorado First and Existing mini grants to serve the training needs of small businesses with 25 or fewer employees. Mini grants are intended to offer equitable and manageable grants for businesses with a small number of employees and limited management capacity; and provide opportunities for small business to access quality training to upskill their employees, increase employee opportunity and retention, and remain competitive with larger Colorado companies. There is a 10% or 40% company match depending on the company type. Grant applications may include training provided by the college, college contractors, qualified grantee employees; and, on a case-by-case basis, qualified third-party training vendors.

SMALL SCALE MANUFACTURING

According to strongtowns.org small scale manufacturing businesses create a tangible product - in any material - that can be replicated or packaged. The business can be all about technology (for example a supply chain businesses that uses 3D printers to supply parts to the Department of Defense) or can be artisan (for example a consumer-facing business that handcrafts leather handbags). It can be food-based or material based (like all natural lotions). Small-scale manufacturing businesses help create thriving places, with business ownership opportunities and good-paying jobs that other business types cannot fulfill. They are hidden gems in the economic development strategy and downtown reinvestment efforts of every place.


