CREDIT FOR PRIOR LEARNING

Adult learners often bring a wealth of experiences with them into higher education that can apply to their fields of study. Credit for Prior Learning (CPL) is one way students can receive credit for these experiences without requiring them to take courses on subjects they have already mastered. Research from the Council for Adult and Experiential Learning (CAEL) and WICHE found adult learners who participate in CPL are more likely to complete a credential, compared to their peers who do not.
