## Concurrent Enrollment for High School Students

Trinidad State's Concurrent Enrollment Program allows high school students to enroll in college courses concurrently. High school students earn both high school and college credits. Concurrent credits earned through Trinidad State are recorded on the student Trinidad State transcript.

Students must be approved by their high school for enrollment in concurrent enrollment courses. Please check with your local school district regarding their policies concerning concurrent enrollment.

Concurrent Enrollment lowers the initial higher education cost by providing each student college credit at low or zero cost and prepares students for a smooth transfer to college by providing the experience of being a college student.
