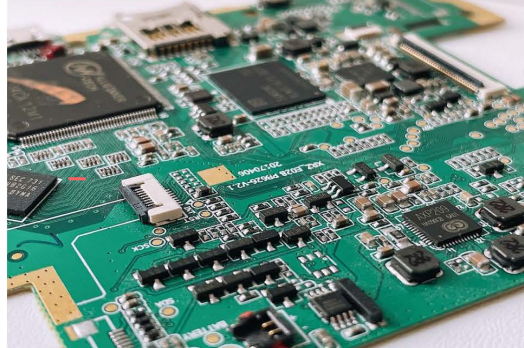
QuickBooks Online Series

QuickBooks continues to be the dominant accounting software used by small and medium-sized businesses. Today more than ever, the cloud-based QuickBooks Online is quickly replacing desktop accounting software versions due to its accessibility and flexibility. This course series will teach you how to manage your business financials using QuickBooks Online.

The Introduction to QuickBooks Online course focuses on key features of QuickBooks Online, so you can gain hands-on experience creating invoices, receipts, and statements; track payables, inventory, and receivables; generating reports; and more. The Intermediate QuickBooks Online course builds upon the skills learned in the Introduction to QuickBooks Online course. You will how to set up your accounts for different types of businesses, enter budgets, and how to track situations in which the owner uses or invests company funds.

Raspberry pi as a computer and other projects

This course will consist of four parts:

- Building a Raspberry pi to use as a computer, installing an operating system, learning to connect to the internet, surf the web, install a word processor, graphics tools, and other topics.
- Programming with Python, making a few basic programs, installing a media player and learning how to use the media player.
- Installing a "pi hole" and configuring it to eliminate ads on your home network and showing essential processes for programming a kit robot.
- Building a gaming machine that functions with game controllers and making a basic security system including cameras and motion sensors.

Students who want to learn the skills without having a project to take home may use the kits provided by the college. If a student wants to complete a project to take home, they will need to purchase the items needed for their projects. A list of items to purchase will be provided to students at the first class.

Each session will run from 3-4:30 p.m. on Thursdays beginning June 11th and ending July 2nd and will be held in the makerspace located in the Freudenthal Memorial Library on the Trinidad State campus. There is no fee to take the classes; however, registration is required and is limited to 5 people.

» President's Scholarship 3.5 – 4.0 GPA

Amount: 6 credit hours paid for on-campus learning, in-state tuition per semester

- Criteria:
- First time degree/certificate – seeking undergraduate student
 - High School/GED GPA 3.5 – 4.0, or have achieved a 1130 or higher score on the SAT
 - Students must carry 15 credit hours per semester Fall/Spring
 - Maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher to sustain the scholarship
 - Colorado students must apply for the College Opportunity Fund (COF)
 - Submit official high school transcript to verify eligibility

Duration: Up to four semesters or 60 credit hours based on academic performance

Deadline: Fall Semester ~ July 1 Spring Semester ~ December 1

» Automatic Merit Scholarship 3.0 – 3.499 GPA

Amount: 3 credit hours paid for on-campus learning, in-state tuition per semester

- Criteria:
- First time degree/certificate – seeking undergraduate student
 - High School /GED 3.0-3.499, or have achieved a 980-1120 or higher score on the SAT
 - Students must carry 15 credit hours per semester Fall/Spring
 - Maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher to sustain the scholarship
 - Colorado students must apply for the College Opportunity Fund (COF)
 - Submit official high school transcript to verify eligibility

Duration: Up to four semesters or 60 credit hours based on academic performance

Deadline: Fall Semester ~ July 1 Spring Semester ~ December 1

» Learn Local Scholarship

Amount: 3 credit hours paid for on-campus learning, in-state tuition per semester

- Criteria:
- Scholarship available to students who graduated from a high school in the Trinidad/Alamosa service area counties: Alamosa, Conejos, Costilla, Las Animas, Huerfano, Mineral, Rio Grande, and Saguache.
 - Students must carry 15 credit hours per semester Fall/Spring
 - Colorado students must apply for the College Opportunity Fund (COF)
 - Submit official high school transcript to verify eligibility

Duration: Up to four semesters or 60 credit hours based on academic performance

Deadline: Fall Semester ~ July 1 Spring Semester ~ December 1

» Finish Line Scholarship

Amount: 3 credit hours paid for on-campus learning, in-state tuition

- Criteria:
- Scholarship available to students who have earned 45 credit hours and in the final semester at Trinidad State
 - Students must carry 15 credit hours for the final semester
 - Colorado students must apply for the College Opportunity Fund (COF)
 - Students must submit a graduation application and demonstrate they are in their last semester of coursework.

Duration: Last semester at Trinidad State College

More than 60 scholarships are available through the Trinidad State College Foundation. Scholarships are available for new and/or continuing students who demonstrate academic promise in a particular field of study or skill.
