FREE SUMMER TECHNOLOGY WORKSHOP SERIES

The Summer Technology Workshop Series is designed to provide community members with practical, hands-on technology education in a welcoming and engaging environment. The workshops are structured to accommodate participants with little to no technical background while still providing valuable information for more advanced users.

Each session is designed as two 3-hour workshops that combine professional presentations, live demonstrations, guided hands-on activities, open discussion, and participant interaction. The workshops are intended to create a relaxed but highly educational environment where attendees feel comfortable asking questions and actively participating.

The overall goal of the program is to improve technology literacy within the community while helping participants better understand and use modern technology in their everyday lives.
