



At 9:30 a.m. on the 20th of April 1925, a bill was signed at the state capital granting charter for a new junior college in southern Colorado, whose purpose was to, "...give instruction covering the first two years of the usual college course(s) in order to be admitted to different professional schools of the University of Colorado."

With the stroke of a pen, Trinidad State Junior College was born. Read More


