



President's Reflection: A Century of Purpose and Promise

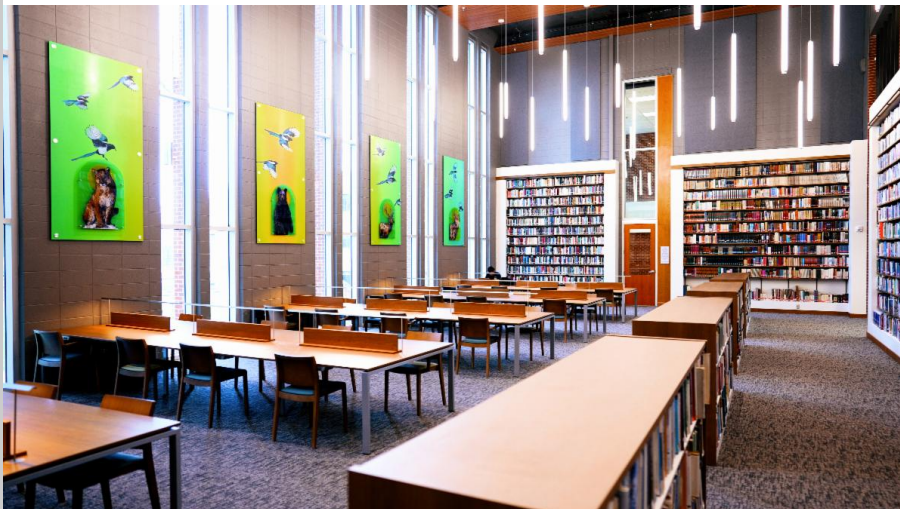
