Society of 1925 Remembers – Jane Workman

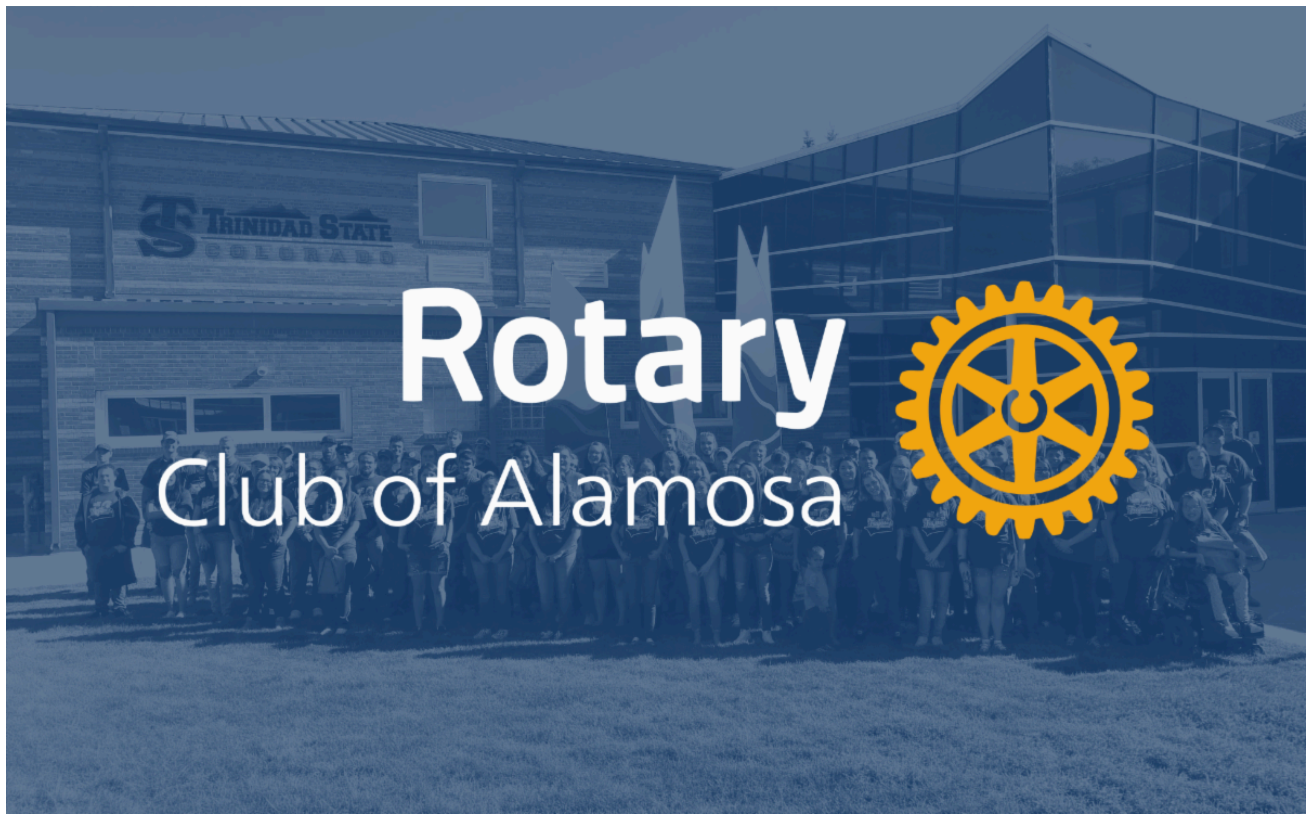

Trinidad State Celebrates Alamosa Rotary Partnership

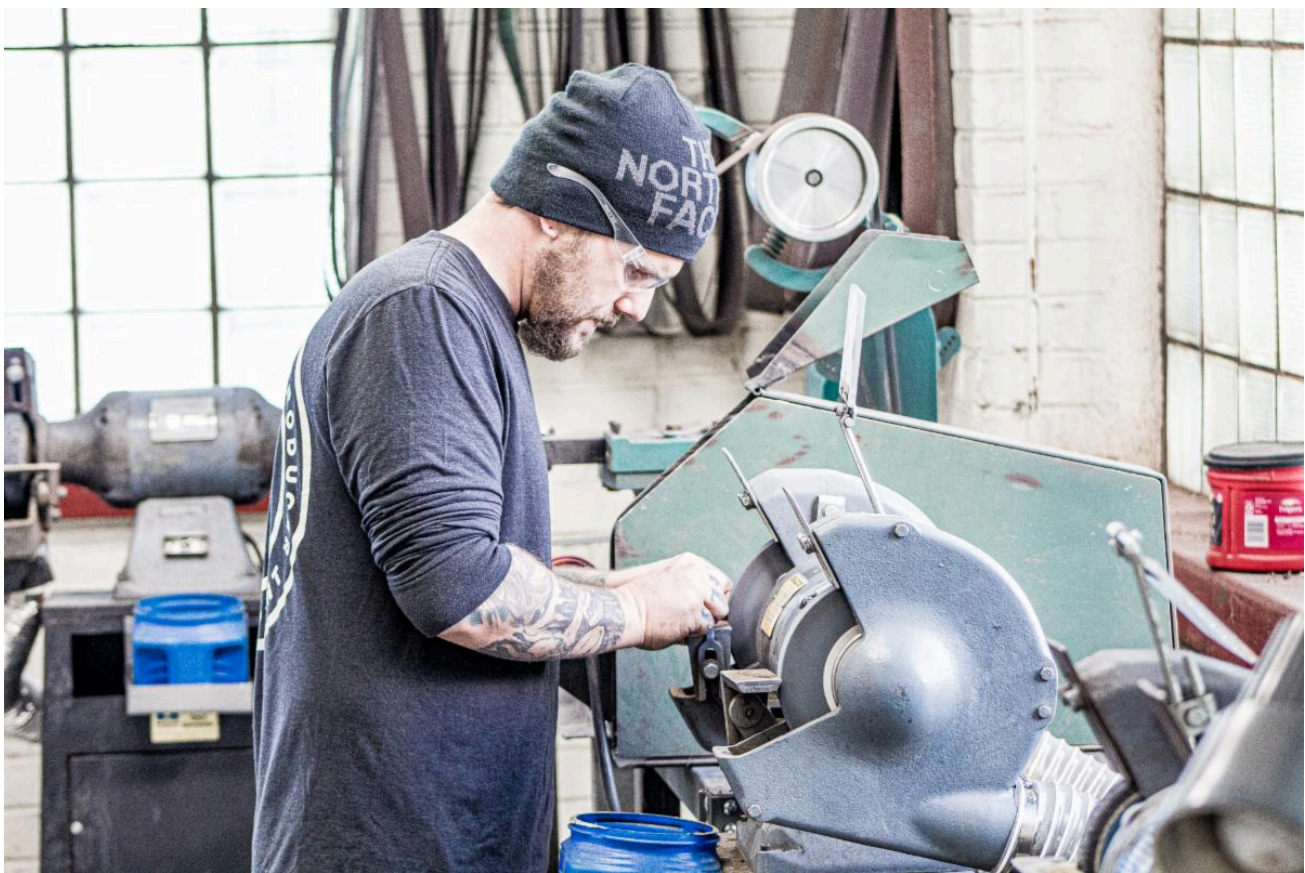

Skilled Trades at Trinidad State

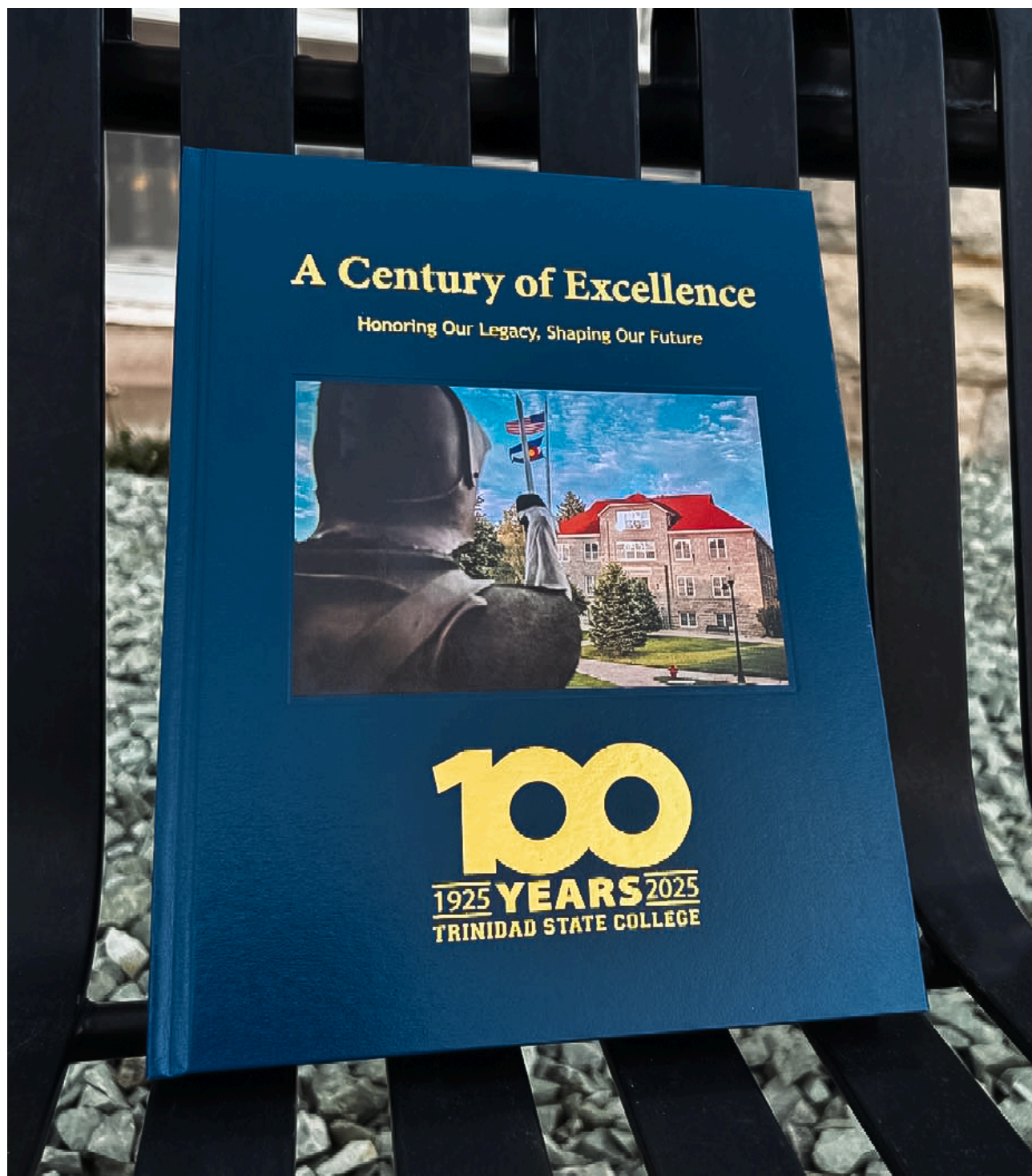
