AMERICAN FIREARMS & SHOOTING FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP

- Must be taking Gunsmithing-related non-credit courses in the summer program
- Must demonstrate financial need (provide FAFSA information or other financial documentation demonstrating need/hardship)
- Two letters of recommendation required (from someone, other than a relative, who can vouch for the student)
- A personal letter explaining your financial need or crisis along with details about educational and personal accomplishments and goals is also required

The NRA Foundation has provided funding for needs-based scholarships to students studying at Trinidad State Junior College in the Summer NRA Short-Term Certificate Program, affording students the opportunity to achieve their educational dreams. NRA Foundation Scholarships will be awarded based upon student merit and/or need using the following evaluation criteria:

- 1. Applicant's record of promoting firearm and hunting safety;
- 2. Applicant's record of participation in shooting sports;
- 3. Applicant's interest in the historic, technological, or artistic context of firearms; and
- 4. Circumstances of financial need.
