Employment Demand and Wage Data:

Entry level jobs in theatre and film, working backstage and behind the scenes, are a growing field with high demand. All jobs listed below are tier 2 according to the Colorado Talent Pipeline report of 2023, providing a high wage. All trends are reported for region 3. It should be noted that accurate demand in gig economy (contract) work is difficult to predict, but growth is evident in all but one field. Broadcast technician median income \$54,365, ten-year job growth 3.5% Event planner is tangential to theatre, but the skill set is the same and many graduates engage in both within the gig economy. Median income \$59,036 and ten-year growth rate of 8.5 % Lighting Designer median income \$54,320 with a ten-year growth rate of 7%. Make-up artist median income \$59,230 and ten-year growth rate of 26.3% Producers and directors with a median income of\$61,663 and a ten-year growth rate of 13% Riggers with a median income of
