Estimated employment wage statistics for individuals in Colorado employed as Preschool Teachers, Except Special Education in 2022 are entry level annual wage at \$32,550 and hourly at \$15.65; mean annual wage at \$40,680 and hourly at \$19.56; experienced annual wage at \$44,680 and hourly at \$21.48.
