Annual wage or salary for hairdresser at an entry level \$17,888 and for an Experienced hairdresser \$31,753. Hairdressers, hairstylists, and cosmetologists' average hourly wage is \$10.95 on a national level. There is an estimated 11,874 2012 hairdresser, hairstylist and cosmetologists employed in Colorado, and having 564 annual average openings.</p> |
